CENSORSHIP WON'T STOP HEMP!

HEMP SA's election campaign "rolled along" on Monday, despite a centrepiece of the campaign, the "Growing All the Way" exhibition at MISS GLADYS SYM CHOON, Rundle St, City being censored by junior members of the SA Police. Alleged complaints saw store manager Joff Chapel threatened with a arrest, if he did not cover up portions of the images as Channel 7 News reported. (15/9/97)

Ironically it was not the images of indoor marijuana horticulture, or the obscenity of prohibition, that offended them, but rather a matching set of "his and hers" genitalia! "I saw Michelangelo's "David" many years ago in Adelaide, without a fig leaf," Joff Chapel said. We wonder now, whether it too would be censored? And if not, what's the difference? The exhibition by photographer Matt Nettheim documents and some say controversially celebrates the blooming growth in growing marijuana indoors using hydroponics.

"Under the Liberals new "three plant plan" all of the pictured growers could be jailed for two years and fined \$2,000!" said Jamnes Danenberg, HEMP SA's "joint" Upper House Candidate. "A vote for HEMP sends the right message; we're serious about reducing crime, and making our community safer. We certainly don't want our kids convicted and sent to jail for growing Cannabis!", he said on Monday.
