GRASS ROOTS CAMPAIGN MOVES AHEAD!

HEMP SA announced it's 1997 State Election ticket today, fielding candidates for both the Upper and Lower Houses. HEMP activist Jamnes Danenberg will again contest the Upper House, whilst the electors of Elder, Hanson and Reynell will be given the opportunity to show their support for re-legalising marijuana by voting for Ms Jo Stokes, Mr Mark Eckermann (from the Cannabis Law Reform Society) and Ms Cathy Crago (from Roseworthy HEMP Information Network).

At the last election in 1993 HEMP stood with three aims.

- 1) To raise to profile of drug law reform politically, and initiate informed discussion and debate about all aspects of hemp.**
- 2) To educate the community about why we must end prohibition.**
- 3) To demonstrate public support for Marijuana law reform.**

HEMP achieved these goals, coming fifth out of twenty two parties with our 16,353 votes denying the Liberals control of the Upper House. In 1997 HEMP believe that their preferences will be critical in deciding the outcome of Elder, Hanson and Reynell, and are confident of winning the last seat in the Upper House.

“This is not a pipe dream” said Mr Danenberg, “Real pundits know that the last seat in the Upper House is the only real question left to be decided, and HEMP has as good a chance as any of the other minor parties” he said.
