SA Election: Internet Site Controversy

HEMP SA today denied suggestions that its popular website <www.hemp.on.net> is misleading. The website contains a page entitled "Your State Cabinet on Drugs" featuring pictures of press photos of the State Cabinet which have been digitally distorted.

"Naturally we aren't saying that the State Cabinet use Cannabis", said Mr Marijuana Legalise, HEMP SA Campaign Manager. "I'm sure they're far too boring for that." "The point is to have a laugh - These people's plans need to be laughed at - they are planning to put SA Cannabis homegrowers in jail for two years and they also refuse to let SA farmers compete with Victoria, where their Premier Jeff Kennett has announced a 10 000 ha industrial hemp crop." Mr Legalise said.
